**E. WORK SESSION**

***1. May/June Events***

A report was given on the proclamation of May as Historic Preservation Month and the presentation of the Certificate of Recognition to the Vietnamese Christian Missionary Alliance Church. Several council members were in attendance. The plaque of the Scriber Bridge is on hold as we wait for a "nice" day to put the car on the bridge. Commissioner Little will contact an architect who might be able to do a presentation on preservation of historic houses.

***2. Planning for 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary***

During the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary year, the possibility was mentioned of placing historic photographs within the public facilities. Investigation will be made to see if photographs can be located in the Convention Center for a season

### ***3. Walking Tour***

Senior Planner Rivera presented directions and sites that could be developed into a 3½ mile walking tour, north of 196<sup>th</sup> St. SW. It might be extended into a certified Volkswalk and publicized as a 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary event. Neil commented that it might be able to tie it in with cell phones with recorded history as part of the tour. Possibility exists also for a mapping exercise with the locations. Senior Planner Rivera will have more details in June.

### ***4. Identifying Historic Sites***

A map incorporating historic sites in the Unincorporated Urban Growth Area is not yet available. Identification of historic sites was postponed until a later meeting due to time constraints
