



### ***3. Historic Street Signs***

The Historical Commission chose to focus initially on the intersections of 44<sup>th</sup> Ave. W. and 196<sup>th</sup> Street S.W. and Highway 99 and 196<sup>th</sup> Street S.W. although some problems may exist with the 196<sup>th</sup> and Highway 99 being state highway regarding additional signage. A resolution should be prepared to be forwarded to the City Council from the Historical Commission.

### ***4. Miscellaneous***

Senior Planner Rivera presented information and inquired about one item:

- Tribute to Marie Little - Councilmembers Utter and Ross will present to the City Council the proposal to name a drive or lane after Marie. Costs of the signs will come from the Historical Commission 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary allocation. Consensus was to have the name applied to the entrances at Heritage Park. Placement of the street name would occur before the end of the year. Request will be made that the reception following the dedication of the signs be in the upper portion of the Wickers Building. Alderwood Heritage Association and the Genealogical Association will be approached regarding co-sponsoring the reception. Investigation is still being made as to whether a park street or the street into the Little Plat would be named after Marie Little
- It needs to be published that the Historical Commission is seeking new members.
- Council member Utter commented that she had been in contact with members of the volkswalking club and they thought the route in the City was too dangerous. The possibility exists that we can do our own walk in the spring as a celebration to close off the 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary year.
