Driving Directions to Lynndale Park Amphitheater-18927 72nd Avenue West

Heading North on I-5 (from Seattle)

- Take Exit #181A (44th Ave W)
- Turn left off exit ramp onto 44th Ave W and go under the freeway overpass
- Turn left onto 196th ST SW
- Cross HWY 99, continuing on 196th ST SW
- Turn right onto 68th Ave W
- Turn left onto 189th PL and park in lot at dead end

Heading South on I-5 (from Everett)

- Take Exit #181 (HWY 524/196th ST SW)
- Turn right off exit ramp and continue on 196th ST SW
- Cross HWY 99, continuing on 196th ST SW
- Turn right onto 68th Ave W
- Turn left onto 189th PL and park in lot at dead end
