WHAT: A juried art exhibit of teen artwork from Lynnwood High School students sponsored by the Lynnwood Arts Commission.

WHEN: March 19 – April 22, 2010

WHERE: Lynnwood Library Art Gallery, 19200 44th Ave West.

HOW TO APPLY: Lynnwood High School Students are invited to create artwork that meets the below rules. Fill out this application, and submit artwork to Ms. Seniuk in room NE 132 with this application taped to the back of artwork. Artwork will be judged and up to 12 sculptural pieces and 30 wall hung pieces will be selected to be on exhibit. Selected students will be notified by email by Monday, March 15, 2010.

Note: Applying does not guarantee selection of art piece.

DEADLINE TO APPLY: Thursday, March 11, 2010

Requirements and Conditions (Please read the following information carefully)

- By applying to be in this exhibit, you agree to the terms and conditions stated in this form.
- Must be artwork you created.
- Students may enter more than one artwork. Each artwork has to have its own entry form attached to it.
- Artwork may be any medium, including paintings, drawing, collage, sculpture
- Wall hung (2D) artwork may not exceed 24”h x 24”w.
- Do **NOT** frame artwork. (selected artwork will be prepared for hanging)
- Sculpture and other 3D work may not exceed 10”h x 10”w x 16”d.
- You give permission to use photos or video of accepted artwork for promotion of the exhibit, including the website.
- This is a public space visited by people of many cultures and nationalities, and of all ages. We reserve the right to not exhibit work that we deem unsuitable. (For example, works that contain nudity, or inappropriate language.)

Liability

Please be advised that every reasonable precaution will be taken during the receiving, installation, exhibition and return of your artwork, but the Lynnwood Arts Commission, the City of Lynnwood, its officials, officers, employees or volunteers do not assume responsibility for loss or damage that might be incurred during this process. All work needs to be of substantial enough nature to withstand these procedures.
